

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES



Tampa Campus Library Scholarship:

Annually awarded academic scholarship to full or part-time USF students who are also library employees on the Tampa campus. Minimum 3.0 GPA, completing their freshman, sophomore, or junior year, and who has successfully integrated an understanding of library resources into his or her course of study.



George & Bobbe Karpay Book Scholarship:

Annually awarded \$500 book scholarship to a full or part-time USF student on the Tampa campus. 3.2 GPA required, and preference for Gaither High graduates second to Chamberlain High graduates.



Altrusa Club of Tampa Scholarship:

The Altrusa Club of Tampa Bay Inc. is a chapter of the national women's service organization, and the Altrusa Collection in Special Collections includes the club's archives of various items such as club scrapbooks, photographs, meeting minutes, and more that document their service to the community. Two scholarships are awarded annually (one each semester) to full or part-time USF students, at all academic levels, pursuing all majors, in all colleges, on the Tampa campus. Must submit an essay stating how you'll use the Altrusa Collection for research purposes. All essays reviewed by the USF Libraries Scholarship Committee.



Boyadjian Family Endowment:

The Armenian Studies Program is housed within the USF Tampa Library's Holocaust & Genocide Studies Center. Awarded one semester annually to full or part-time USF students, all academic levels, pursuing all majors, in all colleges, at any USF campus. Must submit an essay about their interest in Armenian culture.



Fustukjian Memorial Scholarship:

Annual scholarship awarded to a full or part-time USF student with financial need on the Tampa campus.

Apply for scholarships through USF AwardSpring at usf.edu/financial-aid/scholarships, and fill out a questionnaire.
